

## Energy Efficient Renovation Requirements for Major Residential Additions and Alterations

## What projects are applicable?

Beginning August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025, any single-family residential project in the City of Santa Cruz that is a major addition or alteration.

- Major Addition is any change to an existing building that increases the conditioned floor area by 350 SF or more in a one-year period.
- Major Alteration is any construction or renovation to an existing structure with an area
  of 350 SF or more in a one-year period. Exceptions: A project that consists only of roof
  and/or window replacement is not considered a Major Alteration. Additionally, repairs
  are not considered a Major Alteration.
- A combination of a Major Addition and Alteration adding up to 350 SF or more is also applicable.

## What are the requirements?

There are three requirements:

- 1. Utility Room, Kitchen & Laundry-Related Electric Ready Pre-Wire.
- 2. Select at least one or a combination of "Efficiency Upgrade" options for a minimum of 9 points. Options or Efficiency upgrades include installing heat pump water heaters, solar panels, and insulation, among other things.
- 3. If the project includes upgrading to a 200-amp panel, electric-readiness for a heat pump water heater and heat pump space heater is required.

## The Applicant's Process:

- 2. On the form, provide the project information, applicability, and the selected measures.
- 3. The completed intake form must be added to your plan set. Ideally, it should be located at the start of the project's Title 24 Part 6 energy compliance documents.
